**The Epiphany of the Lord:** One of the traditions associated with the Epiphany of the Lord, found in the Directory of Popular Piety, concerns the blessing of homes. Using chalk, a householder marks the inside of the main door of the house or lintel with the initials of the Magi and the current year connected with crosses (20+C+M+B+23). The initials CMB are also the first letters of the blessing: Christus Mansionem Benedicat (May Christ bless the house). Blessed chalk is available at the back of the church should you wish to follow this tradition.
