

JUBILEE YEAR 2025: Pope Francis has announced that the Church will celebrate a Jubilee Year in 2025, with the theme of "*Pilgrims of Hope.*" In addition to the jubilee year itself, Pope Francis announced that there would be two years dedicated to helping people prepare for the 2025 celebrations. 2023 – The Year of the Council - The Second Vatican Council emphasised the universal call to holiness. Pope Francis called on all Catholics to return to the four Constitutions of the council – Sacrosanctum Concilium, Dei Verbum, Lumen Gentium, and Gaudium et Spes. On the diocesan website, there are videos of expert theologians guiding you through each of the constitutions, as well as introductions and reflection questions to help you reflect on the themes within them. Links to the full constitution documents are also provided. 2024 – The Year of Prayer - Pope Francis has called on all Catholics to spend this year, deepening their prayer lives. The diocesan website will be updated regularly with resources and suggestions to support you as you seek to encounter Jesus in your prayer life.
