This Sunday: We have a 2nd collection for the Priests' Retirement Fund for our diocese. This annual collection helps support our sick and retired priests. It allows us to help retired priests living on their own with rental costs and utility bills; it goes towards care home fees where needed; and also enables us to help with medical costs. We currently pay out about £300,000 per year to support our sick and retired priests. Your generosity is much appreciated, and we do hope that you are able to make a generous donation. Eucharistic Adoration: There will be Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament in St Peter's Church next Sunday, the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus Christ (Corpus Christi), from 2.30pm ending with Benediction at 4.15pm.
