

Lourdes Pilgrimage 2022 Cancelled: Clifton diocese has announced that the annual pilgrimage to Lourdes will not be going ahead again this year due to the ongoing pandemic. Bishop Declan made the announcement this week following careful consideration on the impact it could have on the pilgrims, especially those who would need assistance. It will be the third year that the Lourdes pilgrimage has been called off due to Covid. The relics of St Bernadette however are to visit Clifton cathedral later this year. A section of bone from her thigh is to be taken to the major cathedrals and churches of the dioceses of England, Scotland and Wales in the autumn.

World Day of the Sick: Friday February 11th, the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes, is the 30th World Day of the Sick.
