**Good Friday - Day of Fast and Abstinence:** On this day we unite with the whole Church throughout the world in prayer and fasting. There will be a retiring collection after Liturgy of the Lord's Passion at 3.00pm for Holy Places and Christians in the Holy Land.

**At the Foot of the Cross:** A time to reflect through words, music and silence on Good Friday at 7.00pm.

**Confession:** Times to avail of the Sacrament of Confession this week: Tuesday 7.30pm – 8.00pm; Wednesday 6.30pm – 7.15pm, Good Friday 12noon – 1.00pm. Please note there are no confessions on Holy Saturday.

**Polish Food Blessing (Święconka):** Will take place in Church on Holy Saturday from 10.30am – 11.30am.

**Prayer Intention of Pope Francis for April:** For health care workers who serve the sick and the elderly, especially in the poorest countries; may they be adequately supported by governments and local communities.
