

Journey in Faith (RCIA): Next meeting is on Thursday 15th February 6.30pm for a 6.45pm start in the sacristy.

Lent 2024: The Season of Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, February 14th. Mass with the blessing and distribution of ashes at 12noon and 7.00pm. Ash Wednesday is a Day of Fast and Abstinence. **Fasting** is observed by all 18 years of age and older, who have not yet celebrated their 59th birthday. On a fast day, one full meal is allowed. Two other meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids, including milk and juices, are allowed. **Abstinence** is observed by all 14 years of age and older. On days of abstinence, no meat is allowed. Bishop Declan is to celebrate Liturgies of Reconciliation during the Season of Lent at five venues across the diocese, including here at St Peter's on Wednesday 13th March at 7.00pm. There will be a number of priests available to celebrate sacramental reconciliation. **We Dare to Say** is a resource for small group faith-sharing and for individual meditation, featuring five sessions each based on a line from The Lord's Prayer, ideal for the Season of Lent. The booklets are priced at £1 and are available at the back of church. My Day by Day Lent (75p) and My Day by Day Junior and Infant (free) are also available at the back of the church.

The Lent Encounter: Where is Jesus in the Old Testament? Take a journey through the Old Testament this Lent to find the answer. Sign up for free at biblesociety.org.uk/lent2024 and you'll receive a free daily devotion from Ash Wednesday to Easter.

The Chrism Mass: Wednesday 27th March 2024, 11.00am at Clifton Cathedral. Bishop Declan will be the main Celebrant and will bless the three oils — the oil of catechumens, the oil of the sick and holy chrism. A coach will be arranged from St Peter's and more details will be available in the coming weeks.
