

Baptisms: We welcome to family of the church Jakub Wittstock and Isabella De Gala baptised this weekend.

July 19th: The Bishops' Conference of England and Wales have issued Covid-19 Route Map Step 4 Guidance, effective tomorrow July 19th. The guidance can be viewed on www.cbcew.org.uk. Here in St Peter's, we will be cautious over the coming weeks in returning the church to its full capacity, gradually opening up more pews week on week. From tomorrow there will no longer be a requirement to book a place for Sunday masses. We strongly recommend that those attending mass continue to wear a face covering. Hand sanitiser will continue to be available. We will gradually reintroduce singing. However, those who choose to sing must wear a face covering while singing. Altar Servers will be reintroduced in September. The physical Sign of Peace will remain suspended. It is recommended that Holy Communion continues to be received on the hand. The obligation to attend mass on a Sunday continues to be suspended, and will be until well into the autumn. Mass will continue to be livestreamed. We have a shared responsibility to be sensitive to the anxiousness many feel at this time.

Clergy Training Fund: The retiring collection taken across the Diocese this weekend enables the Bishop to support those who offer themselves for training for the Diocesan priesthood. This fund enables the Bishop to fund their training at seminary and offer them a grant during their years of formation. The fund, at times, is also used to support the on-going formation opportunities for clergy in our Diocese and the formation of Permanent Deacons. There are a limited number of gift aid envelopes for this collection at the back of the church.

Fr Stephen Corrigan writes: 'I want to thank you from the bottom of my heart for all the gifts, cards, support, and prayers I have received from the parish. I am so grateful. I have very fond memories of the nine-month placement I spent with you all two years ago, and I am delighted that I will be re-joining your community in September, and that you will be the first parish I serve as a Priest. World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly: Pope Francis has instituted a World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly, taking place this year on July 25th. Identifying with the more senior members of our society, he says "The whole Church is close to you – to us – and cares about you, loves you and does not want to leave you alone!" Pope francis goes on to say that we should cherish the elderly and recognise that there's no retirement age from the work of proclaiming the Gospel and handing down traditions to grandchildren. We invite anyone who wishes to do so, and especially children, to write the names of their grandparents (living and dead) and/or draw a picture of them on a small piece of paper, maybe in the shape of a heart, attach a string or ribbon to it and then hang it on the 'grandparents prayer tree' that will be at the front of the church next weekend.
