

Therefore, this new venture gathers catechists, experienced and inexperienced, to meet on-line to share ideas and to possibly receive a little bit of formation at the same time. These meetings will ensure a crossover of deaneries so that good practice can be shared across the diocese. These meetings will be via *Microsoft Teams*. A *Teams* invitation to the session will be sent out a few days before each meeting.
