**COVID-19:** Churches are still permitted to be open for the public celebration of Mass. However, just because we can still come to mass doesn't necessarily mean we should continue to do so in the way and frequency we normally do. All masses are live streamed and can be accessed on www.churchservices.tv/gloucester.

**Sunday of the Word of God:** In his Apostolic Letter *Aperuit Illis* issued on September 30<sup>th</sup> 2019, Pope Francis declared the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time each year as *Sunday of the Word of God.* At the end of the letter Pope Francis says, *May the Sunday of the Word of God help his people to grow in religious and intimate familiarity with the sacred Scriptures. For as the sacred author taught of old: "This word is very near to you: it is in your mouth and in your heart for your observance".* 

**New Lectionary for England and Wales:** For a number of years the Catholic Bishops of England and Wales have been considering the publication of a new edition of the Lectionary to replace that originally published in the year 1969 (second edition 1981). After consultation with a number of English-speaking Conferences of Bishops, the Bishops of England and Wales studied the translation of the Catholic Edition of the English Standard Version (ESV) of the Bible produced by the Catholic Bishops' Conference of India. From this text they have produced a Lectionary for the Church in India which has received '*confirmatio*' by the Holy See. The English Standard Version: Catholic Edition is seen as fulfilling the qualities the Church seeks when

- considering a translation of scripture namely:The evaluation and use of source material;
  - Accuracy of translation which conveys the meaning of the biblical authors;
  - Dignity and accessibility of language needed for a worthy proclamation of the Word of God.

The Bishops of England and Wales agreed in November 2018 that this text should be the basis for the new edition of the Lectionary to be used in their territory. It is expected that the bishops will complete their approval process in Autumn 2021. The text will then need to be reviewed by the Holy See and others. The earliest date for publication would therefore be in 2022. For more information visit the news page on the Bishops Conference of England and Wales website, www.cbcew.org.uk.

## Summary of the Holy Father's words at the General Audience last Wednesday, January 20th

Dear Brothers and Sisters, from 18<sup>th</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup> January each year, we celebrate the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity. In these days, all Christ's followers are asked to pray in a particular way to the Father for the gift of unity, in order to proclaim the Gospel to a world torn by conflict and division. Our response to discord and division must first and foremost be to pray for the healing and reconciliation that Christ won for us by his saving Passion. We are called to share in Jesus' own prayer at the Last Supper "that all may be one... so that the world may believe" (*Jn 17:21*) and find salvation. In these troubled times, Christians are called to bear witness to the Lord's reconciling love and persevere along the path to full and visible unity. The theme for this year's Week of Prayer, "Abide in my love and you shall bear much fruit" (*cf. Jn 15:5-9*), reminds us that the love of Christ is the basis of all communion between Christians and the inspiration for our efforts to recognize our rich diversity in the Holy Spirit, to overcome our divisions, and to work together in the service of God's Kingdom of concord, justice and peace
