We invite anyone who wishes to do so, and especially children, to write the names of their grandparents (living and dead) and/or draw a picture of them on a small piece of paper, maybe in the shape of a heart, attach a string or ribbon to it and then hang it on the 'grandparents prayer tree' at the front of the church. **Current Situation:** The Bishops' Conference of England and Wales have issued Covid-19 Route Map Step 4 Guidance, effective July 19<sup>th</sup>. The guidance can be viewed on www.cbcew.org.uk. Here in St Peter's, we will be cautious over the coming weeks in returning the church to its full capacity, gradually opening up more pews week on week. There is no longer a requirement to book a place for Sunday Mass. We strongly recommend that those attending mass continue to wear a face covering. Hand sanitiser will continue to be available. We will gradually reintroduce singing at mass beginning this weekend with the 6.00pm Vigil Mass and 10.30am Sunday Mass. However, those who choose to sing must wear a face covering while singing. Single use hymn sheets will be made available. Altar Servers will be reintroduced in September. The physical Sign of Peace will remain suspended. It is recommended that Holy Communion continues to be received on the hand and will be offered under the form of bread only. The obligation to attend mass on a Sunday continues to be suspended and will be until the first Sunday of Advent. Mass will continue to be livestreamed.

**Volunteering:** As we gradually build a new normal within the life of our parish, volunteers are sought to fulfil the following ministries and roles: Readers, Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, Musicians and Singers, Catechists and helpers for Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation Programmes, Welcomers, Church Cleaners, Parish Committee Members (Pastoral, Finance, Buildings). We are very grateful to all who have and continue to fulfil many of these ministries and roles in the life of our parish.
