Coronation of King Charles III: The Bishops of England and Wales have agreed that our catholic Communities should mark the Coronation of the King by praying for his intentions as he is Crowned on 6th May. In line with the suggested format that there should be a triduum of prayer in each parish from Wednesday 3rd to Friday 5th to pray for the King as he assumes the fulness of his responsibility, the following will take place in St Peter's Church. Wednesday: Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament 11.00am – 12noon with the rosary at 11.15am. Thursday: Mass for the intentions of King Charles III at 6.00pm. Friday: Rosary at 10.15am. Prayer cards for the Coronation are available at the back of the church.
