November is sometimes known as the Month of the Holy Souls and it can be good to make this a particular prayer intention during the month.

Saint John Henry Newman: is being declared a Doctor of the Church by Pope Leo next Saturday as part of the Jubilee for Education. He is also being declared co-patron of Education. Saint Thomas Aquinas is the existing patron. Saint John Henry Newman will be the 38th person to be declared a Doctor of the Universal Church. A 'Doctor of the Church' is a man or woman of great holiness and learning whose teaching and wisdom not only resonated with their own contemporaries, but still illuminates, instructs and inspires today. Very few people in the history of the Church have been given this title, beginning with some of the early Church Fathers like Saint Ambrose and Saint Augustine, up until Saint Thérèse of Lisieux. They are now joined by Saint John Henry Newman.
